

Rising Star Quilt Guild Mystery Quilt 2020 - 21

General Information

This mystery quilt will produce a small comfort quilt consisting of 2 different blocks that together form several patterns. Depending on whether you choose light or dark fabrics the focus may look different. You will need a minimum of four (4) different fabrics to complete the top. I am leaving the borders up to you to make, as you would like.

Fabric A small print or solid, if scrappy should be close in color

Fabric B must contrast with fabric A, any kind of print will work, though not directional

Fabric C this could be all different fabrics;

Fabric D parts of this could be scrappy; 2 or 3 fabrics

Both fabrics C and D should not blend in with A or B or each other – pick a color scheme or a design quality that is distinctive so it is clear which ones are C and which are D fabrics.

Fabric needed **for blocks only!** You will need more for borders

Color	3X3	3X5	5X5
Fabric A	1/3 yard	1/2 yard	3/4 - 1 yard
Fabric B	1/4 yard or fat quarter	1/3 yard	2/3 yard
Fabric C	1/4 yard or fat quarter	1/4 yard	1/2 yard
Fabric D	1/4 yard or fat quarter	1/4 yard or fat quarter	1/2 yard

3 blocks by 3 blocks

5 - 8" Block 1

4 - 8" Block 2

1 1/2 " border and 4" border

24" X 24" plus borders - 36"X36" comfort

3 blocks by 5 blocks

8 - 8" Block 1

7 - 8" Block 2

24" X 40"

5 blocks by 5 blocks

13 - 8" Block 1

12 - 8" Block 2

40" X 40" plus borders which could include a 4 patch row, or piano keys, or flying geese to make this large enough for a bed.

Schedule

Sept. - Fabric requirements and info

Oct. - Clue #1

Dec. - Clue #2

Jan. - Clue #3

Feb. - Clue #4

March - Clue #5 Sew blocks together, add any desired borders

April - time to sandwich, quilt and bind into a finished quilt

May - June - Send in pictures or bring (optimistically hoping we will meet in person by then) finished quilt or top.
