

RSQ Round Robin Quilt 2025-26

Basic operations for the round robin process

1. This is strictly optional—only play if you really want to and are prepared to keep to the schedule
2. Over the summer, each person starts by making the center block of their choice, 8"- 12", you decide color palette and style. The center block can be rectangle or square with a maximum perimeter of 48".
3. We will make our first swap at the September RSQG meeting. Each person brings their block in an opaque bag - to be passed to another participant. I will provide for you larger bags or boxes in October, once I know how many I will need.
4. Each person has one month to add a round to the quilt—bringing the Kit back to the next in-person meeting to pass to the next person.
5. You are welcome to add any extra fabric to the kit that goes with or you used in your section. This allows the following members to use it in their section which will add unity to the whole quilt. You are NOT required to use any of the extra fabric you find in a kit.
6. The center block does not have to end up in the center! For example: two sides of your "border" can be 4" wider than the other two sides.
7. You will turn your kit in to me, Jessica, when you arrive at the next meeting. You will receive a new kit at the end of the meeting.
8. If you realize you have to miss a meeting please let me know ASAP. If you can send your finished piece with someone else who is coming to the meeting, who will then take your next section to bring to you, that would be best, I can help facilitate that if need be. Otherwise I will figure out a way to make the swap.
9. Some round robins limit participants to certain styles, colors or techniques. You are free to use whichever styles or techniques you want, the only rule is that what you add must pair well with the rest of the piece.
10. After the final border is added and pieces are returned in May you will get the quilt top that has the center block you made.

I am planning for the schedule of swapping to be:

September - bring center block

October - first addition

December - 2nd addition

March - 3rd addition

April - 4th addition

May - 5th/final addition - reveal the final tops.
