Who says English Paper Piecing (EPP) has to be just hexies and diamonds? Customize your own English Paper Piece (EPP) project! This technique and project is the perfect portable project. Take it with you while traveling. Have only 10 to 15 minutes at a time? This is an easy project that is great for using up fabrics in your stash and is easy to pick up and put down. Sheri will walk you through all the steps while demonstrating tips and tricks for staying organized, working efficiently, achieving precise alignments and sewing with different stitches to piece both straight lines and curves. This workshop is geared towards the beginner or those who are challenged by English Paper Piecing. Students will practice their EPP skills while making letters of their choice from Sheri's pattern, Typecast. Sudents will have one letter well underway by the end of class. Students can make additional letters to customize their own quilt. The possibilities are endless!

\*\*\*PRIOR TO CLASS, YOU WILL NEED TO PRE-ORDER YOUR PAPER PACK LETTERS Orders must be placed by **April 26**, 2024 in order to guarantee your materials will arrive at your home in time for class.\*\*\*

- Typecast EPP Pattern Guide (\$10)
- AND at least 1 Typecast paper letter (\$5/letter)

  If you would like to practice sewing curves in class, which is highly recommended, be sure to select letters that contain a curve

**Option 2: pre-order** the <u>Complete Typecast Paper Pack</u>, all 26 letters included, with the <u>Typecast EPP Pattern Guide</u> (\$83.99)

For both options, paper letters can be used over and over again. If you would like me to hand deliver your set, enter the code "RISING" at checkout and select free shipping. If you would like the templates shipped to you prior to class, select the flat fee shipping option.

#### What to bring to class:

- 1. At least a Fat Eighth (or equivalent) of fabric for each letter
- 2. At least a Fat Eighth (or equivalent) of fabric for background of each letter
- 3. A small acrylic ruler, cutting mat and rotary cutter
- 4. Water Soluble Fabric Glue Marker
  I use the Sewline and Fons & Porter brands
- 5. Sharp fabric scissors with fine point tip

  I use Karen Kay Buckley Medium 6"—agua handle
- 6. Thin, sharp Milliner, Sharps or Straw sewing needles
  I use Tulip Hiroshima Big Eye Milliner Needle #10. If you need these, I sell them
  on my website here:

- 7. Thin good quality thread that matches your fabric as closely as possible I use Aurifil Cotton 80wt and 50wt
- 8. A few Clover Wonder Clips or mini binder clips
- 9. Bees wax or Thread Conditioner
- 10. Thimble(s) and/or Adhesive Thimble Pads

  I use the adhesive type
- 11. Reminder— don't forget to pre-order your paper letter(s) PRIOR to class—info above. Each student needs at least one paper letter and the Typecast EPP Pattern Guide in order to work on their project in class.
